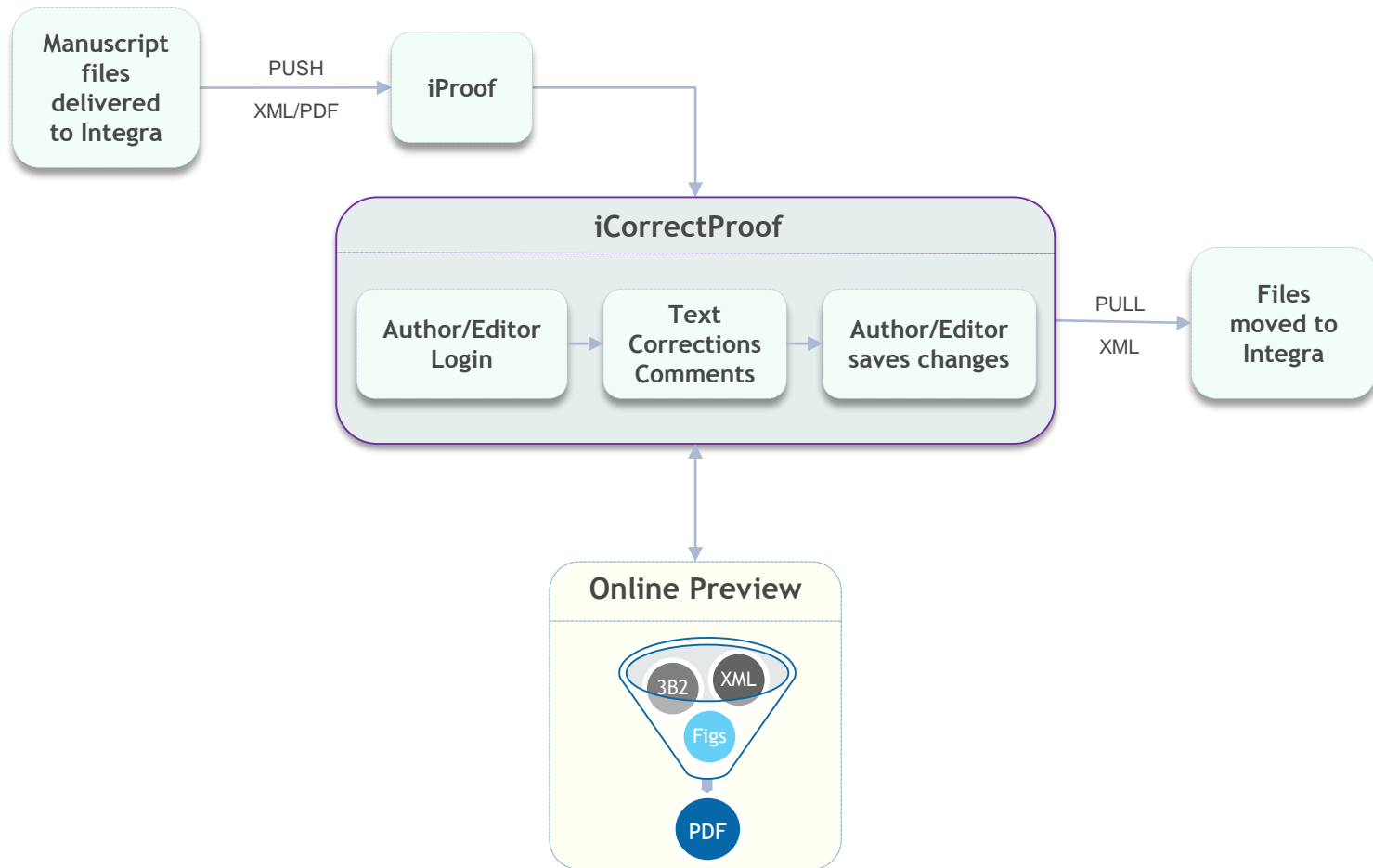
# INTRODUCTION

- Wolters Kluwer is continuously striving to improve its services and modernize its publishing processes.
- In the conventional proof correction process, the author does hardcopy editing, annotates PDFs, or edits in Word. This process is time-consuming because corrections require multiple people and processes to correctly implement.
- Our partnership with Integra to use *iCorrectProof* introduces a solution for journals. This document highlights some features & benefits and outlines the implementation process.

# WHAT IS *iCorrectProof*?

- An online proof-viewing and author-correction platform that is based on XML in the backend.
- *iCorrectProof* has easy-to-use editing functions similar to MS Word, with real time online previews of changes.
- The objective of *iCorrectProof* is to reduce the time it takes to review proofs and implement corrections.

# FEATURES

- **Content Corrections** (text correction)
- **Basic & Advanced Editing Capabilities** like making formatting corrections, undo & redo functions, inserting / deleting tables, figures or footnotes and automatic reordering, integrated with 3<sup>rd</sup> party reference databases (e.g., CrossRef)
- Managing **Author Query** and space for Author to create **Comments** on Table, Figures, etc.
- **Track Changes** to record changes along with user name and time
- User friendly **Side Panel** for quick access to Comments, Bookmarks, Figures, Tables, etc.
- **Easy Navigation** between XML and the original PDF
- Instant **PDF Preview** by the Author / Editor, along with changes marked in PDF file
- Create **Bookmarks** for later review
- Automatic **File Backup**
- Customizable **Contributor - Editor Workflow**
- **Automatic Reminder** for Authors

# BENEFITS

- **Speed:** Production timeline for journals will be significantly reduced.
- **Proof Preview:** Authors can preview the changes and give approval to the proof quickly which will facilitate speed to market
- **Quality:** Improved quality because corrections will not be missed by the compositor.
- **Ease of Use:** An intuitive design and user-friendly interface.

# IMPLEMENTATION PROCESS

- **High-level email introduction** of *iCorrectProof* to journal editors.
- **Conference call** with editors:
  - Video demo of the platform;
  - Discuss contributor requirements;
  - Confirm workflow process and proof correction times;
  - Confirm starting issue and submission schedule.
- **Give access to test site** vial email to let General Editors try out the platform. A user manual will be available as video and text.
- **Submit journal manuscript** according to 2016 planning.
